### FROM THE PRINCIPAL

### Health Precautions at School:

As I hope parents are aware by now our approach at St Lucy's here at Wahroonga and in our satellite classes continues to be that we function as fully as possible during Term 3. Naturally we are taking additional COVID precautions and constantly reviewing our processes to ensure we are in line with NSW Health guidelines as these change and develop further. We have resumed Friday Assembly for 15 minutes maximum but are not allowed to have parents or external guests present at these events. St Dominic's Day will look and feel very different this year as we are not allowed to have other schools, such as Knox or Prouille, on campus to help us celebrate. Unfortunately Camps for Stage 3 and 4 will not be able to proceed at their respective outdoor education locations but we are seeking to provide some form of alternative arrangements (not overnight stays) instead. More information about this will be communicated to parents nearer the time.

Meantime it is still very important that as a family you each be aware of your own, and your child's health, and if anyone in the family is not well or showing any symptoms, please keep your child at home. If anyone in your family is being tested for COVID we would appreciate you contacting Terry Williamson or Kathleen Walsh to let the School know.

Hello from the therapy team,

This newsletter we thought we would focus on answering questions. This is a task that can be tricky for our students, however, Marion Blank's levels of questions is a great resource to use. In this framework there are four levels of questioning which move from simple, concrete questions (e.g. what is it?) in level one, to more difficult, abstract questions (e.g. why?) in level four. Blank's questions encourage the development of language and vocabulary as well as skills in comprehension, making inferences, predicting and problem solving.

The four levels can be seen in this diagram to the right.

In a few classes we have also been using the colourful semantics 'WH' visuals to cue students about which question type we are asking. See below:
