Celebration of the Life of Dov Kresner:

On Tuesday we hosted the Celebration of the Life of Dov Kresner at school with some 140 people in attendance. Although we have all been deeply moved by Dov's recent passing during the last holidays, we were honoured to invite his immediate family, Ben and Karen and Joel, along with their wider family members and their community of friends including Rabbi Yossi Shuchat for the celebration of his life. A large number of parents and students, especially from Pelican class, attended as did current and former staff. After some prayers and reminiscences from the family and staff and listening to two of Dov's favourite songs - A Twinkl Sea Shanty and See You Later Alligator - we enjoyed supper together. Visitors to the school were able to have a short tour to help understand what St Lucy's is and means to the Kresner family. One of the many highlights of the evening was the dedication of the Buddy Benches painted in yellow (Dov's favourite colour) donated by the Kresner family with handprints from his classmates. These two benches will be placed in the playground for students and parents to enjoy and be a reminder of Dov's courageous life among us as well as his great love for his friends.
