Earlier this term at our staff days we reviewed and refreshed our Fire Evacuation and Lockdown procedures and had an external expert briefing and advising us on the thoroughness of our procedures. Yesterday we had a fire alarm which we later discovered turned out to be a false alarm. We evacuated the students and staff safely and awaited the fire brigade which came very quickly to the school to support us and then give the 'all clear'. The fire brigade were very thorough and identified the fault and this has now been rectified. It was pleasing to see the speed with which the students cooperated in the evacuation to the sunshine on the oval. The students were also thrilled to meet the firemen when they were introduced to the school and were mobbed as heroes, which of course they are serving our community in this way.
