

Joint Communication Statement by Prouille Catholic Primary School and St Lucy's School

Dear Parents,

Both Prouille and St Lucy's are excited by the opportunity of building stronger links.

This opportunity has arisen as a result of the announcement, earlier this year, that St Lucy's is Moving Towards K – 12, starting with Year 7 in 2019, and consequent building works.

Due to the commencement of the building program that is expected to occur at St Lucy's shortly, the Catholic Schools Office Broken Bay has generously agreed to offer assistance to St Lucy's School in accommodating some of their students during construction over the next two years (2019 and 2020). This will be in the form of Prouille providing a classroom for a Kindergarten class of up to 10 students and another classroom for a composite Year2/3 class of 10 students. These two classes will be resourced by the staff of St Lucy's and follow their specialised educational program.

This provides an excellent opportunity for the Prouille Community to extend assistance and offer a very warm welcome to our neighbouring Catholic and Dominican school during this building phase.

Both Principals believe this to be an excellent short term opportunity which will only serve to further enhance the already strengthening links between Prouille and St Lucy's.
